- This is a remote role, but you are welcome to volunteer from the office where possible.
- 3-7 hours a week, flexible to your lifestyle.

EXPERIENCE & REQUIREMENTS

- You will ideally have access to a laptop with internet connection and access to Microsoft programmes such as Word, Excel and Outlook. Knowledge of using these programmes will be necessary.
- Basic experience in a similar role or familiarity of the role description would be desirable.
