

# ROLE PROFILE PHILANTHROPY RESEARCH VOLUNTEER

The role of a Philanthropy Research Volunteer will be to support the team with various research projects necessary to their development.

Your main focus will be researching individuals identified as prospective donors; exploring their interests, motivations, philanthropic history, and potential connections to Helen & Douglas House. This work helps us assess their likelihood of supporting our work and strengthens our approach to engagement.

You may also be asked to help expand our prospect list by reviewing websites and annual reports of other organisations to identify donors that align with our mission.

You will be supported by the Philanthropy Team, and they will brief and quide you on the projects you will be researching.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Researching prospects from a pre-identified list, completing comprehensive research profiles.
- Document research findings in Excel/Word format

- Up to 7 hours a week, flexible to your lifestyle
